

Ming Feng

Principal Research Scientist, CSIRO Oceans and Atmosphere

Dr. Ming Feng is a physical oceanographer of CSIRO. He graduated from Beijing University and received his PhD from a joint program between Chinese Academy of Sciences and University of Hawaii. He worked at the International Pacific Research Center as a postdoctoral fellow before he joined CSIRO in 1999. Ming Feng has been working on the ocean boundary currents, upper ocean dynamics, and biophysical processes in his career. He has played a key role in the multi-disciplinary Integrated Marine Observing System in Australia over the past 10 years, to monitor ocean boundary currents and climate variability around Australia. He also has been serving on the CLIVAR Indian Ocean Regional Panel, and established active international collaborations in China, Japan, and the US. He has published more than 100 scholar publications and made unique contributions to the understanding of interannual and decadal variability of the Indo-Pacific ocean circulation. His multi-disciplinary research has influenced the decision making of marine management in Australia.
