- PTWC is located on Ford Island in Pearl Harbor
- Responsible for broadcasting tsunami alerts to all countries around the Pacific Ocean.
- This tour will introduce AOGS scientists to the new high-tech home of PTWC and to the scientists responsible for analyzing large earthquakes and deciding whether or not to issue an alert.

The Fine Details:

- PTWC is located on Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, a US Naval base.
- Upon receipt of your registration for this field trip, advance paperwork will be sent to you so that you may be pre-approved for access to the base.
- This paperwork must be returned to AOGS by April 1, 2018.
- No refunds or substitutions after April 1, 2018.

On the date of the field trip all participants must carry proper identification to secure their pass. International visitors must present a passport. A secondary picture ID is also suggested, but it is not a substitute for a passport. Domestic visitors should bring U.S. issued drivers license or government issued picture ID. A secondary ID is also suggested.
