  - e. AOGS Membership (Valid for 3 Annual Meetings)
  
- Conditions for Application
  - a. Applicants **MUST** be committed to work for AT LEAST half the conference.
  - b. Applicants **MUST** submit all required information.
  - c. Applicants **MUST** be English-speaking.
  - d. Application **MUST** be submitted by the given deadline.
  - e. Successful applicants **MUST** register by the given deadline.
  - f. Successful applicants **MUST** attend volunteer training.
  - g. Applicants will be required to select the type of volunteer support offered
    - Conference Services: support to participants and at poster sessions
    - Session Assistant: support to speakers and session chairs in presentation rooms
    - Either Conference Services or Session Assistant
