Commonly known as KK, Kon-Kee Liu is the director of the Institute of Hydrological and Oceanic Sciences, National Central University in northern Taiwan. His current research focus is to explore biogeochemical cycles in continental margins using observational as well as modeling approaches. Originally, KK trained at UCLA as an isotope geochemist, specializing in stable isotopes of nitrogen. Since then KK has organized some large field campaigns exploring the biogeochemistry of the East and South China Seas. He is now serving as a member of the Scientific Committee of the International Geosphere Biosphere Program (IGBP).
