MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

The Asia Oceania Geosciences Society (AOGS)

And

The Korea Geoscience Union (KGU)

AOGS and KGU hereby agree to promote collaboration between the two organizations including but not limited to the development of opportunities for their members to expand their international experiences and exchange information on earth and planetary sciences in general and in particular on meetings held by both organizations. In particular, AOGS and KGU agree to the following terms for their collaborative activities

- 1. Neither organization shall have any financial obligation to the other.
- 2. Each organization will offer the other organization one exhibition booth at its main annual meeting at no cost.
- 3. Both organizations will seek opportunities for scientific collaboration of mutual benefit, including but not limited to the organization of joint events, joint sessions on meetings held by both organizations.
- 4. Both organizations will seek opportunities for the exchange of information and collaboration between the business offices.
- 5. Each organization will list the annual meeting of the other organization in its advertisement of upcoming events.
- 6. Both organizations will arrange for the registration fees to be waived for leaders or representatives of the other organization when attending each other's main annual meeting. These registration waivers will be available to a maximum of 2 persons per meeting.
- 7. Both organizations agree to offer each other's members registration at the member rates for their main annual meeting.

This memorandum shall be reviewed every three years and may be dissolved by either organization at any time with 30 days' notice.
